Stuckmeyer's is a 4<sup>th</sup> Generation family farm. We have been at our Fenton location since 1952.

Our goal is to offer the best bedding and vegetable plants to our customers. The plants that we grow and sell are the same plants that we use in our fields. The majority of the produce we sell in our farm market is grown by Stuckmeyer's. Most of the produce you buy has been harvested the same day we sell it.

Since we are family run, normally a<u>t</u> least one family member is close by to answer questions, give suggestions or just around to say Hi! We know sometimes we get called away to help out in the fields, working ground, planting or harvesting. Most for us. Not much spare time of our employees have been with us for years, they are very knowledgeable.

Why do Stuckmeyer's plants grow so well? All of our seedlings are hand transplanted into the cells. We feel that by hand separating the seedlings, this simulates the growth. We "harden off" our tomato plants by exposing them to

the elements outside of the greenhouse. But when the spring storms pop up, it is everyone rushing to move all the plants under cover. But that is what it takes to get a thick stalky tomato plant.

This is a busy time of year as we are busy in the greenhouse and trying to work around the storms getting spring items planted in the fields.

We are looking forward to seeing all of our customers that have been coming to Stuckmeyer's for years!
