Did you know the plants that we grow and sell are the same plants that we use in our fields? We try to produce the best products available so that everyone can be successful in the garden!

Every year is different as everyone that has been gardening in the St. Louis area knows. This year has so far been a slow start getting out

into the fields. We have onions planted, spinach both sowed and wintered over, peas planted, asparagus just waiting to pop. We have also planted many varieties of lettuce including red romaine (new for 2015 "looks tasty!"). Strawberries are just starting to bloom. Every day we are doing a little more. It will be a mad dash again to get all of our fields full, but it is nothing new, we go through this every year. We enjoy this life, which is why we have done this for 4 generations.

We are also signed up for both the Arnold Farmers Market and Old Towne Fenton Farmers Market starting in May on Saturday mornings. We will be selling our local homegrown produce at both of these markets.
